

The project

Europe Goes Local is a European cooperation project to develop and strengthen local youth work.

The 3rd European Youth Work Convention in December 2020, has brought together the European youth work community of practice and identified actions, measures and future steps to support the implementation of the Agenda through the Bore process. Europe Goes Local's mission is to strengthen the youth work community of practice at the local level, in line with the European Youth Work Agenda and from the perspective of municipalities and of local youth work actors.

The project is financed by the contributions of participating National Agencies, in the frame of Erasmus+ (Training and Cooperation Activities) and/or the European Solidarity Corps (Networking Activities). The project is governed by the Steering Group – in charge of the main aims of the project – and the Advisory Board – a forum for planning of European and national activities. The project is running for the period of 2021 – 2027, with a mid-term evaluation in 2024.
