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







# Topics of interest of young people (YouthInfoQuest, 2023)





# Preffered channels of communication (YouthInfoQuest, 2024)






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

Limited awareness among municipal youth workers and decision- makers

Need for more training and support on connecting youth-work and youth information Fragmented or inconsistent services limit access to rights and opportunities for young people
