

Request for offers to create an online and offline database and comparison on European strategies with relevance to the youth field

JINT vzw is looking for a consultant or team of consultants to create a database and overview of horizontal European strategies with relevance to the youth sector. The overview will be a searchable tool embedded into the EGL website as well as a document file.

JINT vzw is the Flemish knowledge centre for international youth mobility and international youth policy and is the implementing National Agency for the Erasmus+ Youth programme of the European Union in Flanders, Belgium.

The project

The EGL project is a long-term strategic cooperation between Erasmus+ National Agencies and their partners.

The core aim of the project is to raise the quality of local youth work in particular through enhanced cooperation between various stakeholders that are active at the municipal level. The Partnership currently involves about 1000 stakeholders all around Europe.

Tasks and expected outputs

1. Building an overview of horizontal European strategies highlighting their relevance for the youth sector
The overview needs to include:
 - The complete and official title and URL of the horizontal strategies
 - The complete and official title and URL of the youth sector strategies
 - A short description of the horizontal EU strategies, mentioning the main theme and purpose of each
 - A short description of the youth sector strategies, mentioning the main theme and purpose of each
 - Quotes of sections and paragraphs of the horizontal strategies which has any relevance for the youth sector
 - 'Youth sector' is understood the following way: youth work policy, practice and research; youth policy, practice and research; youth participation and youth inclusion policy, practice and research; youth volunteering policy, practice and research.
2. Creating a matrix of horizontal European strategies and youth sector strategies showcasing the links between them
3. Creating a set of recommendations for the youth sector on how to build on the horizontal strategies and link their work to it in a strategic way
4. Creating an easy to use, possibly graphic summary document of the key findings
5. Working together with the developer of the EGL-website to turn the written output into a web-based, searchable matrix

Terms and conditions

- Number of consultants to be selected: 1-2 persons.
 - o Offers can be submitted by individual researchers and duos of researchers.
 - o The final number of selected consultants will depend on the professional content and financial offers
 - o Two independently selected consultants will have to carry out the tasks together and deliver a joint output.
- Pricing: 360 €/working day

- Number of working days: this call does not pre-define the number of working days for the assignment. The offers must include the number of necessary working days. Based on the offer of the selected consultant(s), the project coordination will establish the final number of agreed working days together with the consultants.
- Payment: preliminary partial pre-payment will be possible based on a timesheet that contains the completed tasks and related working days. The final payment will be executed when the final output is delivered
- Timeline:
 - o Delivery of the complete overview: 30 September 2026
 - o Delivery of the summary of key findings: 30 September 2026
 - o Launch of the web-based searchable page: 20 October 2026

Profile of the consultant(s):

- Experience in creating policy review and analysis of European policies
- Familiarity with the youth sector in Europe, awareness of the role of different stakeholders and thorough knowledge of the European policy frameworks and agendas
- Fluency in English

The proposals should include:

- The CV of the applicant (or a link to the TOY-profile if it includes the relevant experience)
- A cover letter including a brief description of experience in line with the expected profile and experience
- A detailed proposal of specific tasks to be carried out and the number of working days related to each task
- In case the number of working days cannot be precisely specified for some of the tasks in advance, an approximate number of days is to be included. This should be clearly indicated in the offer
- Duos of consultants can submit a joint offer and cover letter. In that case, a CV is required from both candidates. The proposal should include task division between the two candidates.
